

How to open a CSV file in Excel

Welcome, MobieTrainers!

So, you need to open your Excel file as a CSV file: maybe you're uploading translations, perhaps you just want to access different functionalities in your file.

Let us quickly show you how to open your file in the right away to prevent any strange symbols from appearing.

Let's get clicking!

1) Open your Excel file and go to the tab 'Data'. Click on 'Get Data', in the left corner.

Note: click on the 'Get Data' item, not on the arrow that triggers the drop-down menu!
