

How to open a CSV file in Excel

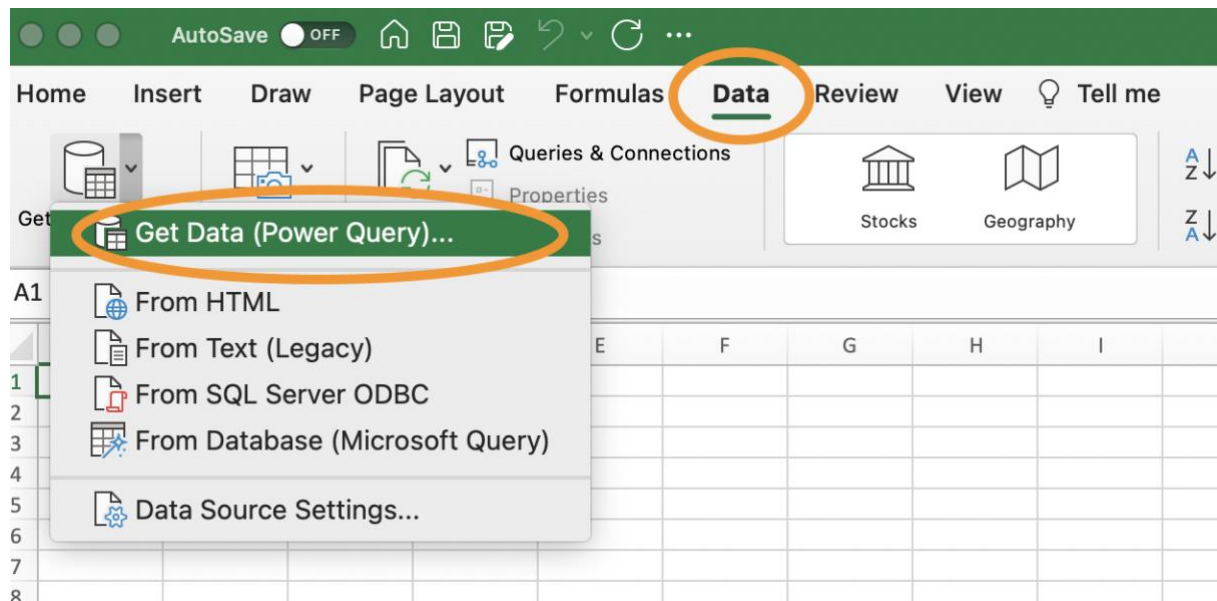
So, you need to open your Excel file as a CSV file: maybe you're uploading translations, perhaps you just want to access different functionalities in your file.

Let us quickly show you how to open your file in the right way to prevent any strange symbols from appearing.

Let's get clicking!

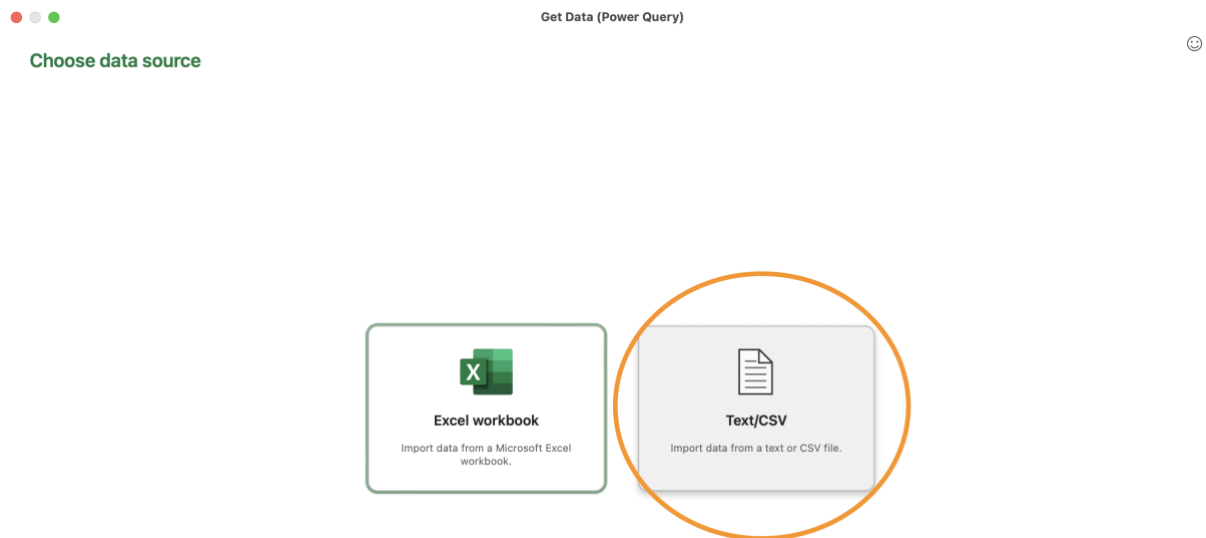
- 1) Open your Excel file and go to the tab 'Data'. Click on 'Get Data', in the left corner.

Note: click on the 'Get Data' item, not on the arrow that triggers the drop-down menu!

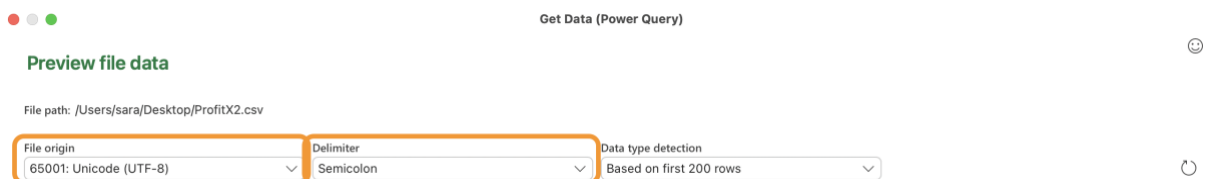


2) You will get a pop-up message stating 'Choose your data source'.

Click on... yes, you guessed it, the **'Text/CSV'** icon on the right!



3) To ensure the right formatting, make sure the first setting is set to **'UTF-8'** and the second one, to **'Semicolon'**.



There you go, there's no step 4!
